

PART II PHYSICALS REQUIREMENTS

PHASE I PHYSICALS ARE CONDUCTED AT THE SOLDIER MEDICAL READINESS CENTER, SMRC, LOCATED BEHIND THOMAS MOORE HEALTH CLINIC. PHASE I APPOINTMENT REQUESTS ARE SCHEDULED BY CENTRAL APPOINTMENTS, 288-8888. THIS INCLUDES BLOOD WORK, HEARING AND VISION SCREENING.

**NOTE: SMRC CONDUCTS PHASE I AND PHASE II PHYSICALS FOR SPECIAL FORCES.

PHASE I CHAPTER PHYSICALS ARE SCHEDULED BY THE UNIT CDR/1SG

NOTE: PER AR 40-501, STANDARDS OF MEDICAL FITNESS, CHAPTER 8-24, (2) (d) (b): ENLISTED SOLDIERS BEING PROCESSED FOR SEPARATION UNDER PROVISIONS OF AR 635-200 , CHAPTER 5, PARAS 5-3 (INVOLUNTARY SEPARATIONS ONLY), 5-11, 5-12 AND 5-17 ONLY, AND CHAPTERS 8, 9, 11 (PARA 11—3B ONLY), 12 AND 18 WILL RECEIVE A SEPARATION MEDICAL EXAMINATION IF THE SOLDIER REQUESTS IT, OR IF, ON REVIEW OF THE MEDICAL RECORDS OR THE DD FORM 2697, A PHYSICIAN, A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, OR A NURSE PRACTITIONER FEELS AN EXAMINATION IS APPROPRIATE (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF INVOLUNTARILY RETAINED (STOP-LOSS) SOLDIERS).

PER AR 40-501, VOLUNTARY REQUESTS FOR MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR CHAPTERS LISTED ABOVE SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMANDER OF THE SERVICING MTF NOT EARLIER THAN 6 MONTHS NOR LATER THAN 1 MONTH PRIOR TO THE ANTICIPATED DATE OF SEPARATION OR RETIREMENT (OR IF APPLICABLE AND REQUESTED BY THE SOLDIER, 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO TRANSITION LEAVE.)

PHASE II PACKETS REQUIRE A HEARING EXAM DATED WITHIN ONE YEAR. IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT SOLDIERS HAVE A DENTAL SCREENING, AS VA MAY NOT FULLY ACCOMMODATE THE SOLDIER ONCE SEPARATED. IF THE SOLDIER REQUESTS DENTAL SCREENING IT MUST BE ANNOTATED ON DD FORM 2808 IN BLOCKS 43 AND 83(a). ALL SCHOOL PHYSICALS REQUIRE ANNOTATED DENTAL SCREENING. SOLDIER MUST APPEAR IN PERSON (WITH ESCORT, IF REQUIRED) WITH COMPLETED PHASE I TO SCHEDULE PHASE II.

CHAPTER 5-13, 5-17, 7, 13 AND 14-12 (a) (b) (c) REQUIRES ALL OF THE ABOVE AND A DA 699-R OR DA FORM 3822: REQUEST FOR MENTAL EVALUATION. CHAPTERS 5-13 AND 5-17 CAN INCLUDE THE 699-R, DA FORM 3822 OR THE DETAILED MENTAL MEMORANDUM. CONTACT YOUR BRIGADE MENTAL HEALTH PROVIDER, EMBEDDED MENTAL HEALTH, (254) 286-6713.

NOTE: THE FOLLOWING CHAPTERS REQUIRE ESCORTS: 5-13, 5-17, 7, 9, 10, 11, 13 AND 14.

A MEMO SIGNED BY THE FIRST SERGEANT OR COMPANY COMMANDER/ACTING COMMANDER W/ASSUMPTION OF COMMAND ORDERS IS REQUIRED LISTING THE SOLDIER'S FIRST AND LAST NAME, UNIT AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. IT MUST ALSO CONTAIN THE ESCORT(S), SGT AND ABOVE, WITH THEIR FULL NAME AND RANK ONLY; NO SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS AT ALL. IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THE MEMO CONTAIN AS MANY ESCORTS AS THE UNIT CAN PROVIDE. THE ESCORT MUST OUTRANK THE ESCORTED SOLDIER BY GRADE.

SMRC WILL GIVE THE PHASE I PACKETS TO THE SOLDIER AND/OR ESCORT AFTER COMPLETION OF THE PHASE I PHYSICAL. THE SOLDIER AND/OR ESCORT LISTED ON THE MEMO MUST APPEAR IN PERSON TO SCHEDULE THEIR PHASE II.

NOTE: THE FIRST SERGEANT OR COMPANY COMMANDERS ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED PERSONS WHO CAN PICK UP A COMPLETED PART II PACKET IN THE ABSENCE OF THE SOLDIER AND ESCORT ON THE MEMORANDUM.
