



Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center Groundbreaking Fact Sheet

QUICK FACTS

Construction will start in March or April 2011. The Medical Center is expected to be open for patients in late summer 2015.

At \$534 million, the project is the largest Department of Defense contract financed with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds.

This is the largest design-build project in the Department of Defense medical construction program.

Darnall serves roughly 45,000 active duty personnel and nearly 125,000 family members and retirees within a 40-mile radius.

In the past seven years, more than 4,200 wounded and ill Soldiers evacuated from Iraq and Afghanistan have been treated at Darnall.

The medical center will have multiple portals of care with a six-story hospital tower, two two-story out-patient specialty clinics and one three-story out-patient speciality clinic all connected by an easy-to-navigate concourse.

It will be designed and constructed to achieve LEED Gold certification.
